REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals)

In response to the European Commission's directive to ban hazardous substances in electrical and electronic products sold in Europe effective July 1, 2006, we certify now that the products of LS ELECTRIC Cheonan Factory are RoHS compliant according to directive 2011/65/EU, as amended by EU 2015/863 of the European Parliament and of the council on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

In response to the European Commission's REACH regulation concerning Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals, we certify as follows: although LS ELECTRIC Cheonan Factory is principally a supplier of articles which do not require registration, we have been actively pursuing a process of contacting our suppliers of substances, preparations, and articles to ensure that all necessary pre-registration and subsequent registration requirements are complied with in the required timescales. This effort extends to all materials used by LS ELECTRIC Cheonan Factory that are within the scope of REACH and with regard to the applications in which the materials are used in our products. We have undertaken this activity with the objective of ensuring that there will be an ongoing supply of all materials used in LS ELECTRIC Cheonan Factory's products and processes and consequently no interruption in the supply of products to our customers.

LS ELECTRIC Cheonan Factory is also aware that the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) has identified a list of substances, <https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table> (cited January 23, 2024), that are under consideration for inclusion in ANNEX XV as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs). We have already determined that our products do not contain any of these SVHCs above the threshold of 0.1% by weight. Additionally, we have managed restricted substances by referring to the revised ANNEX XVII, <http://echa.europa.eu/substances-restricted-under-reach> (cited December 12, 2023), of the REACH regulation for consumer health protection and environmental conservation.
